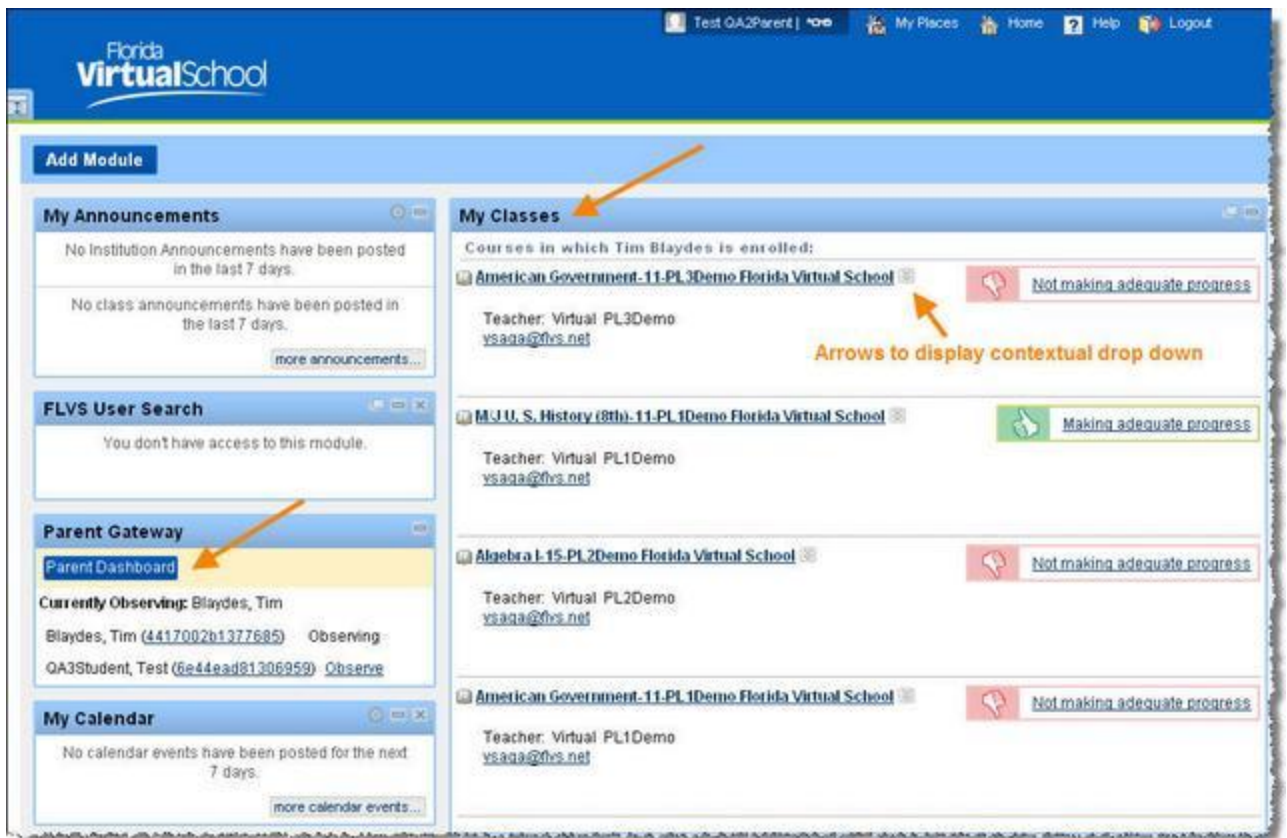

3. Parents will be taken into the Blackboard Learning Management System Dashboard. On the Blackboard Dashboard, parents will see several modules to help them navigate between children and courses.

Parent Gateway – allows parents to observe different students

My Classes – allows parents to select the specific course to monitor

My Announcements – displays course and school announcements



- Parents will select the arrows after the course that they want to monitor (not on the name of the course) and a contextual drop down will display:

- Export information to PDF
- View previous report by date
- See Student Activity Report (dates and times logged in)
- Access student's grades (My Grades) by selecting the drop down option at top of screen denoted by an arrow

Note: Currently, progress reports are automatically created at the midpoint and end of each month.
